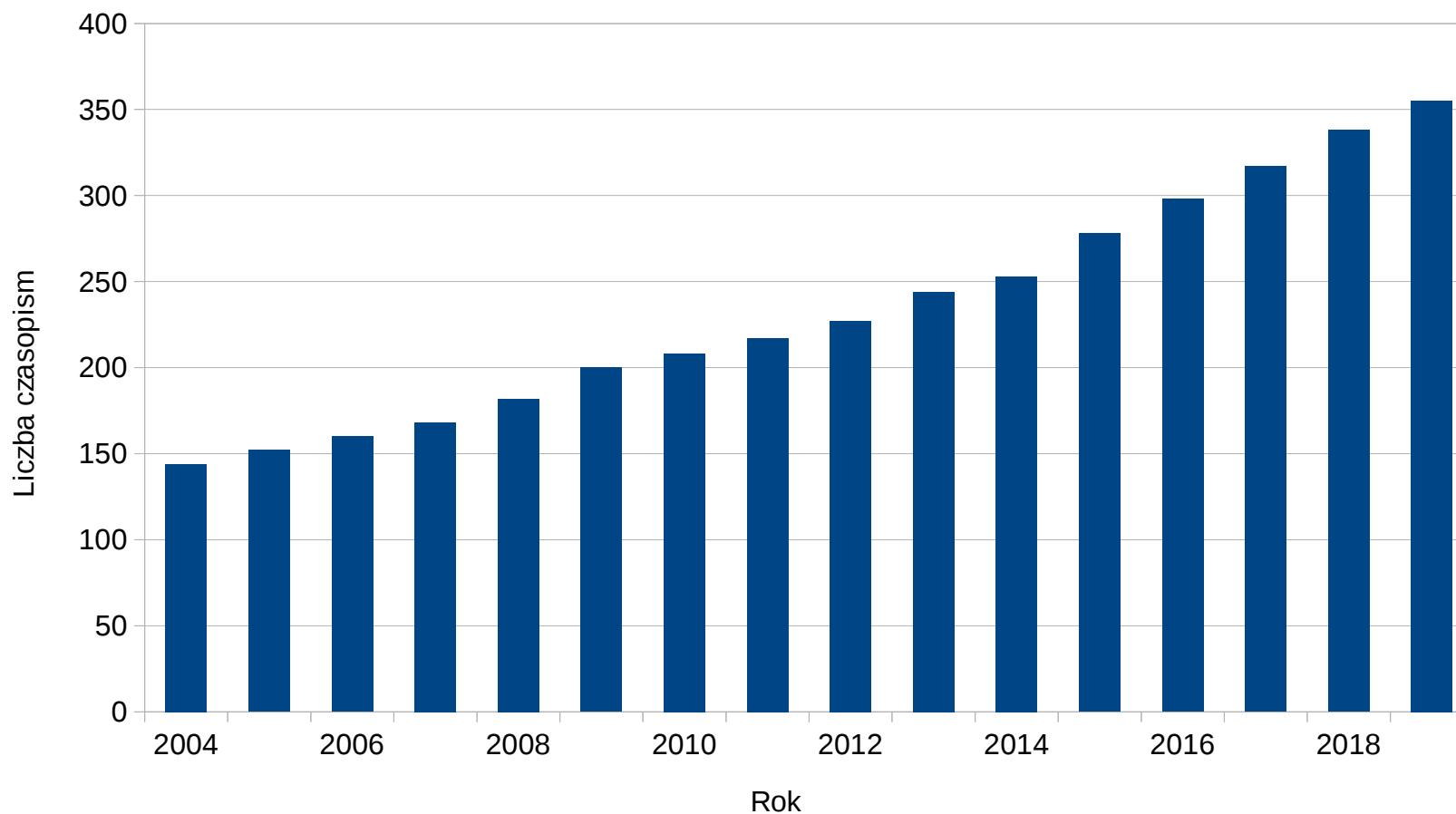

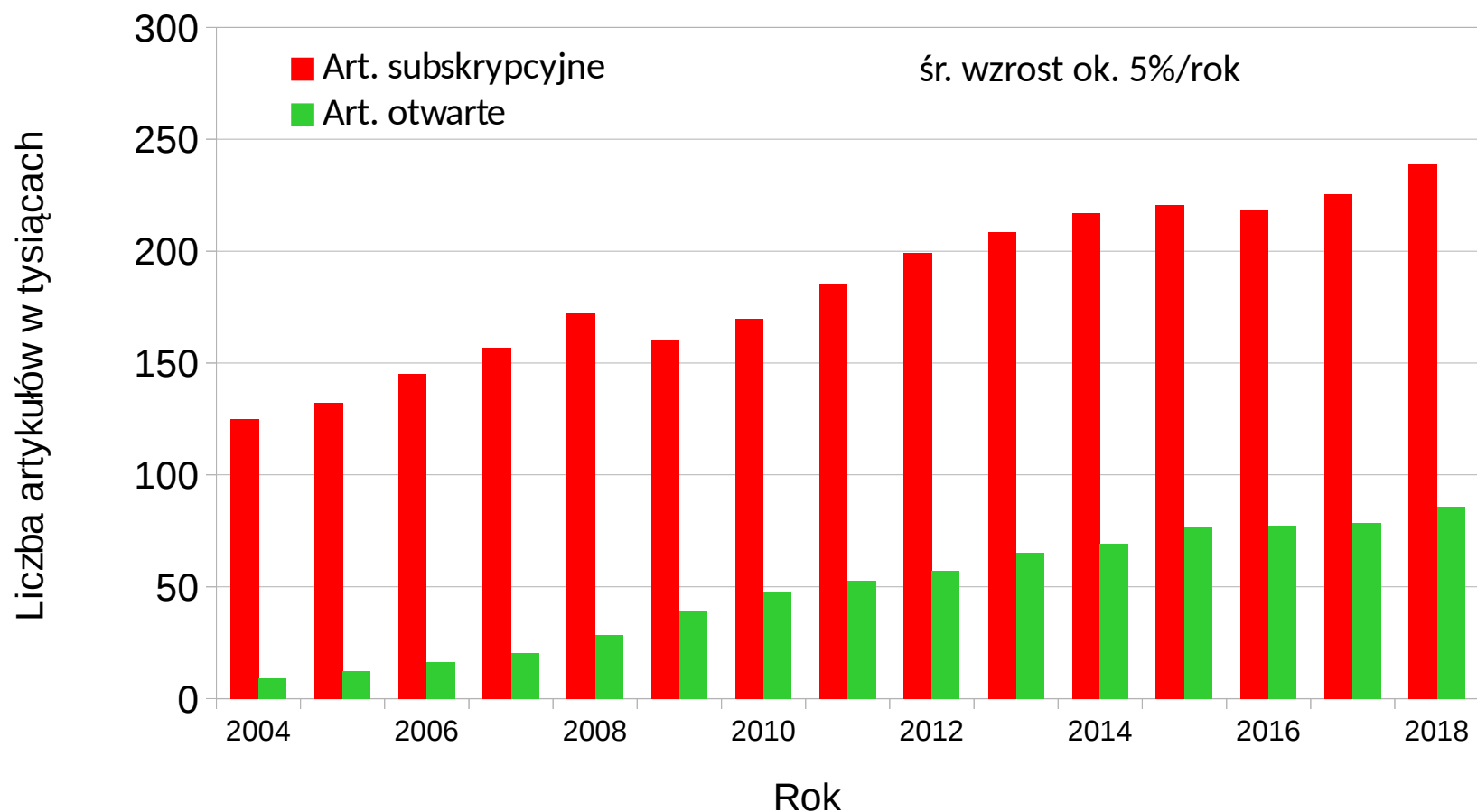

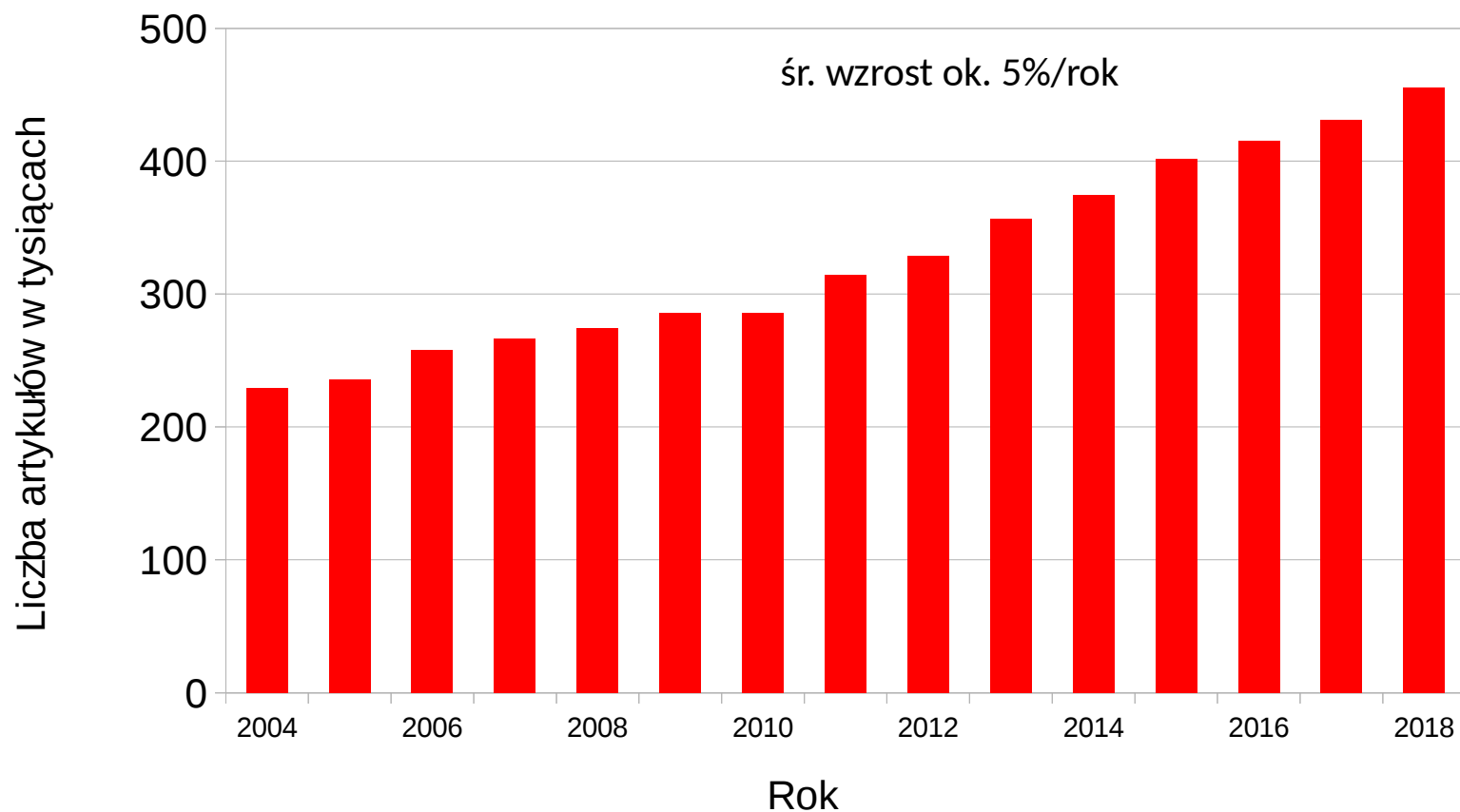
Przykład: liczba artykułów publikowanych rocznie w Springerze





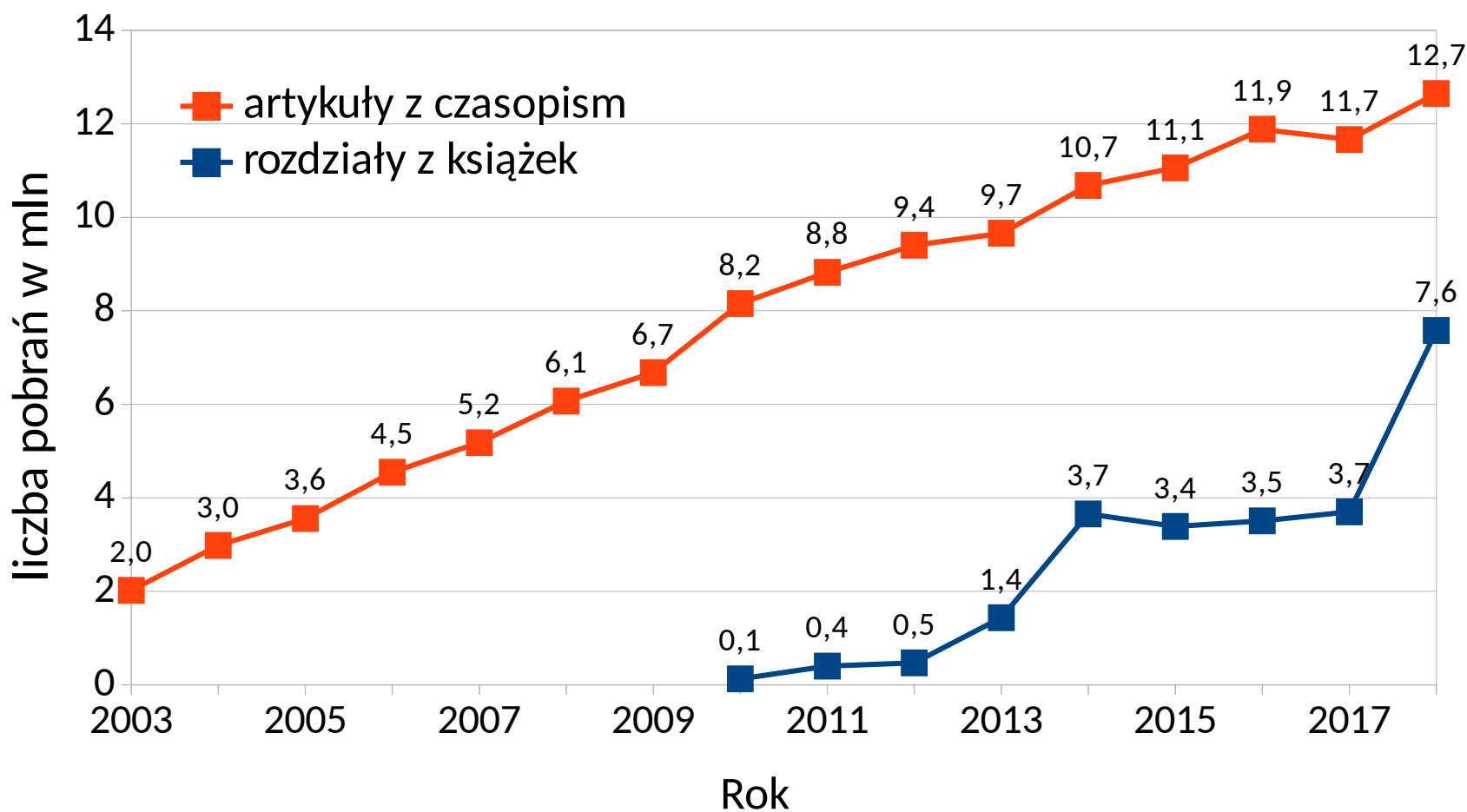

Przykład: liczba artykułów publikowanych rocznie w Elsevierze



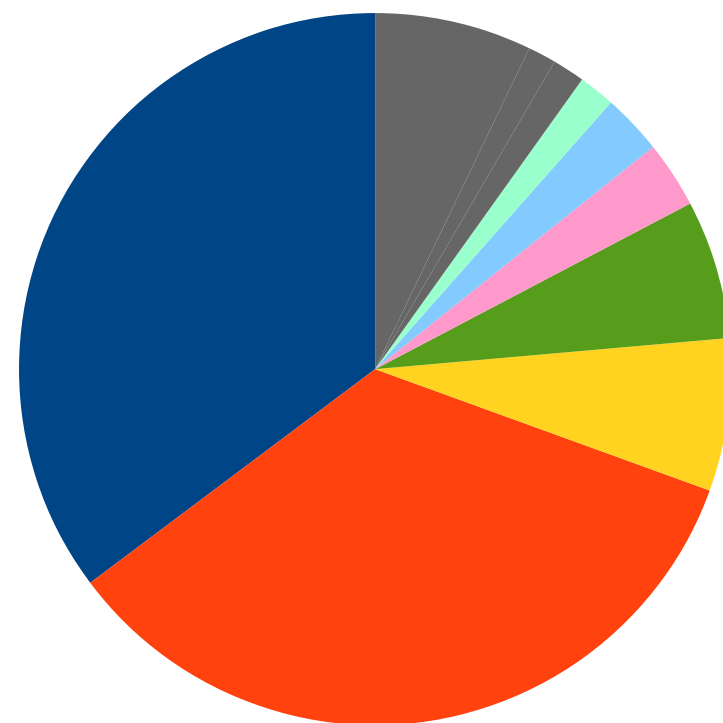

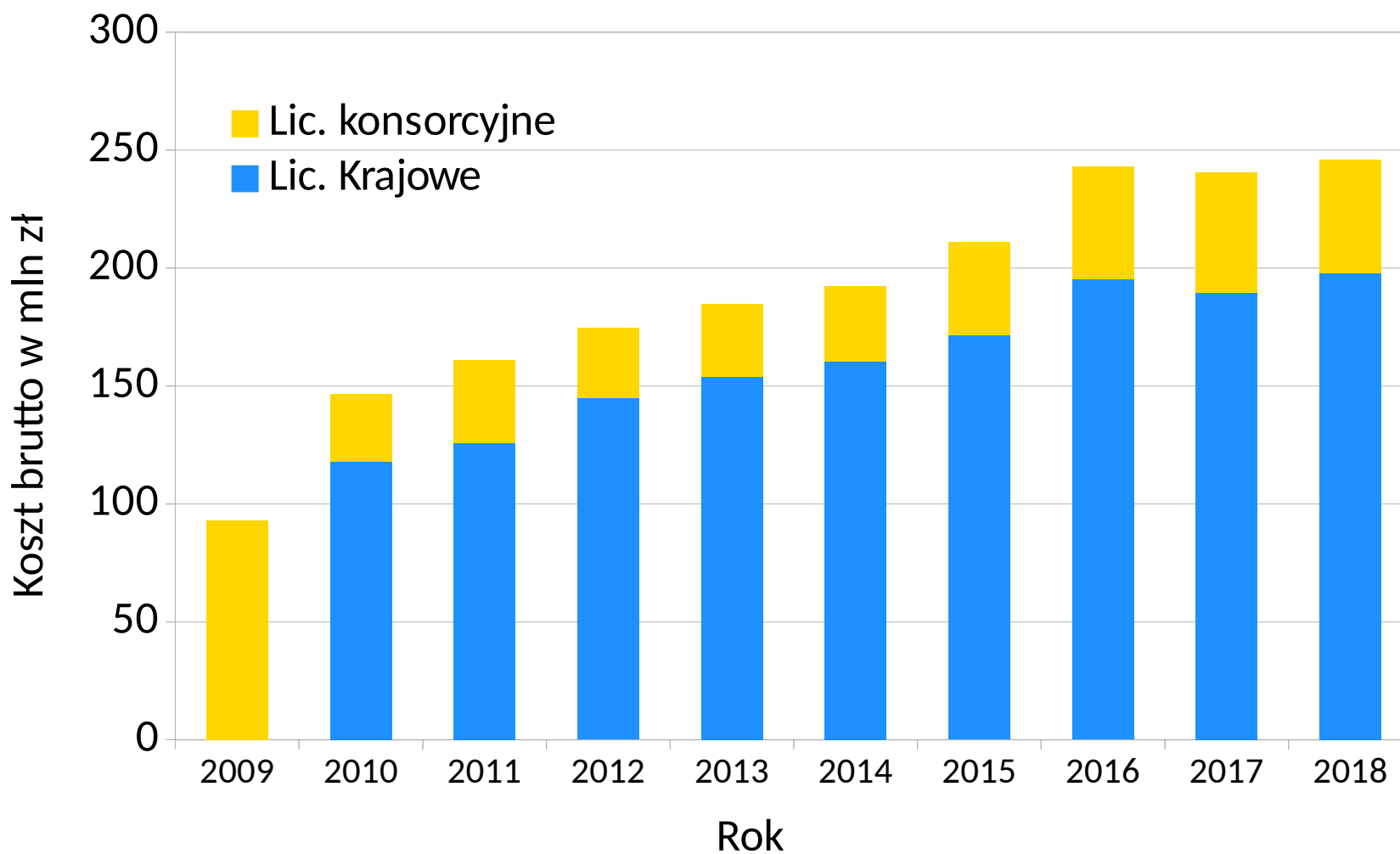

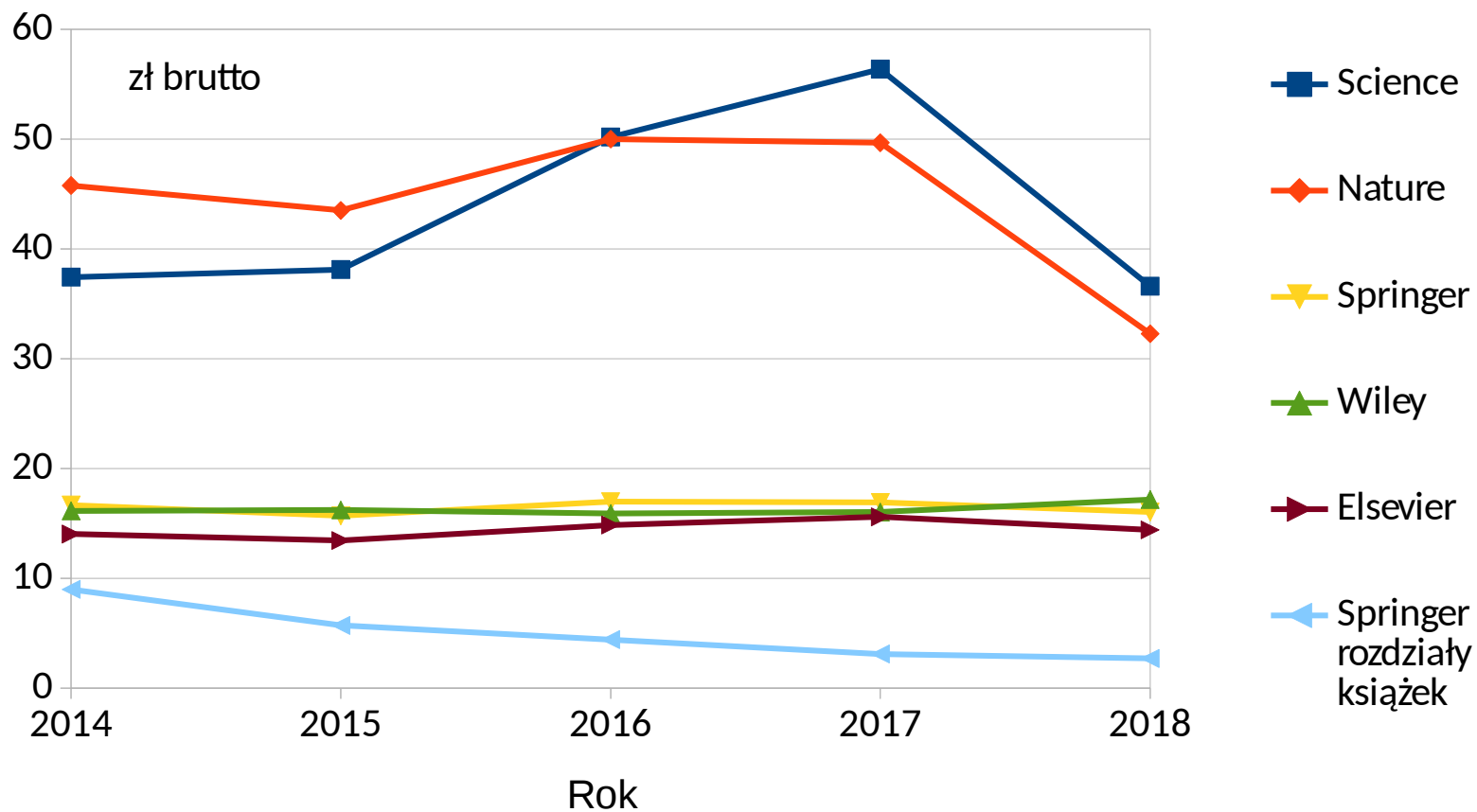

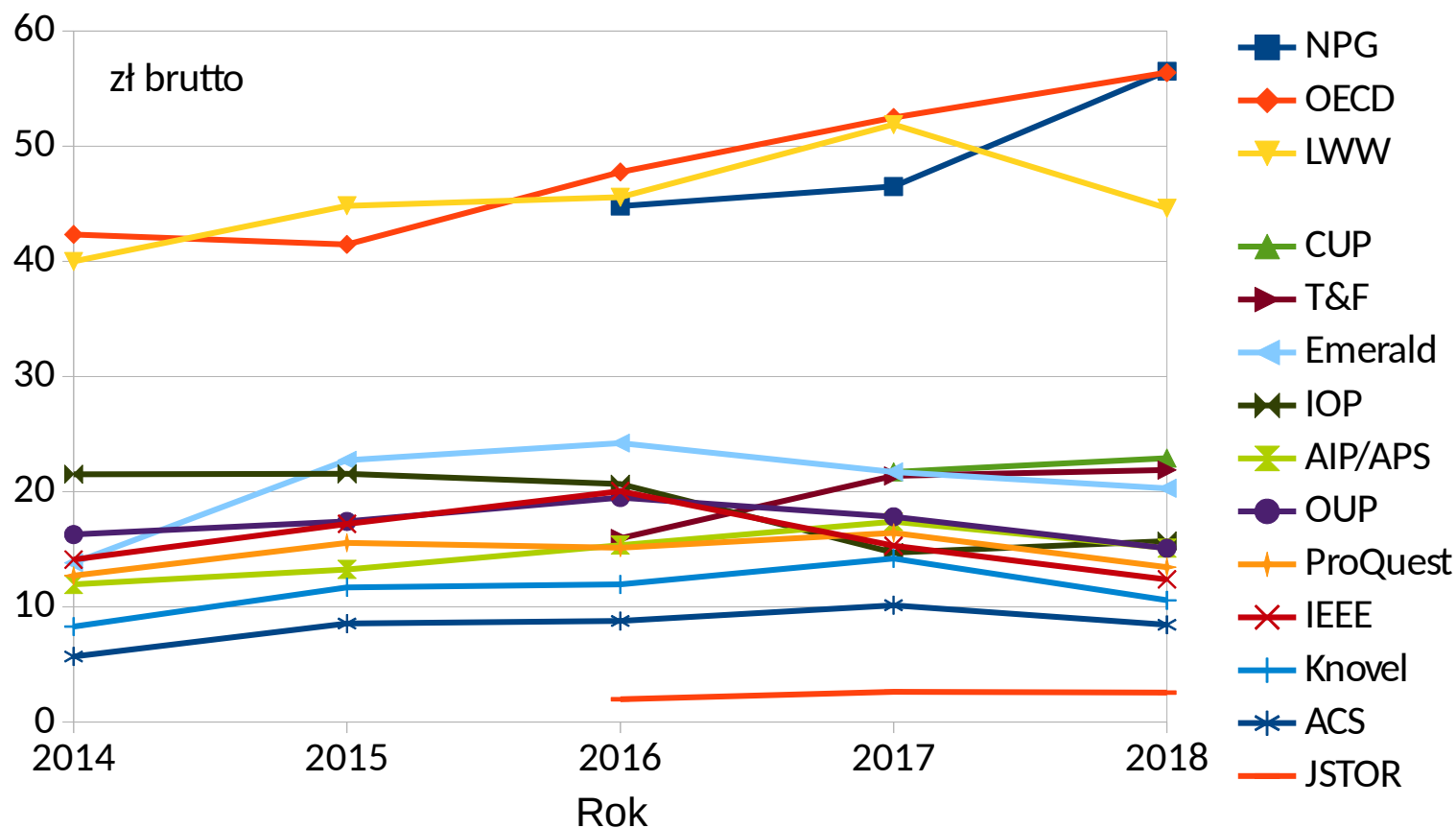

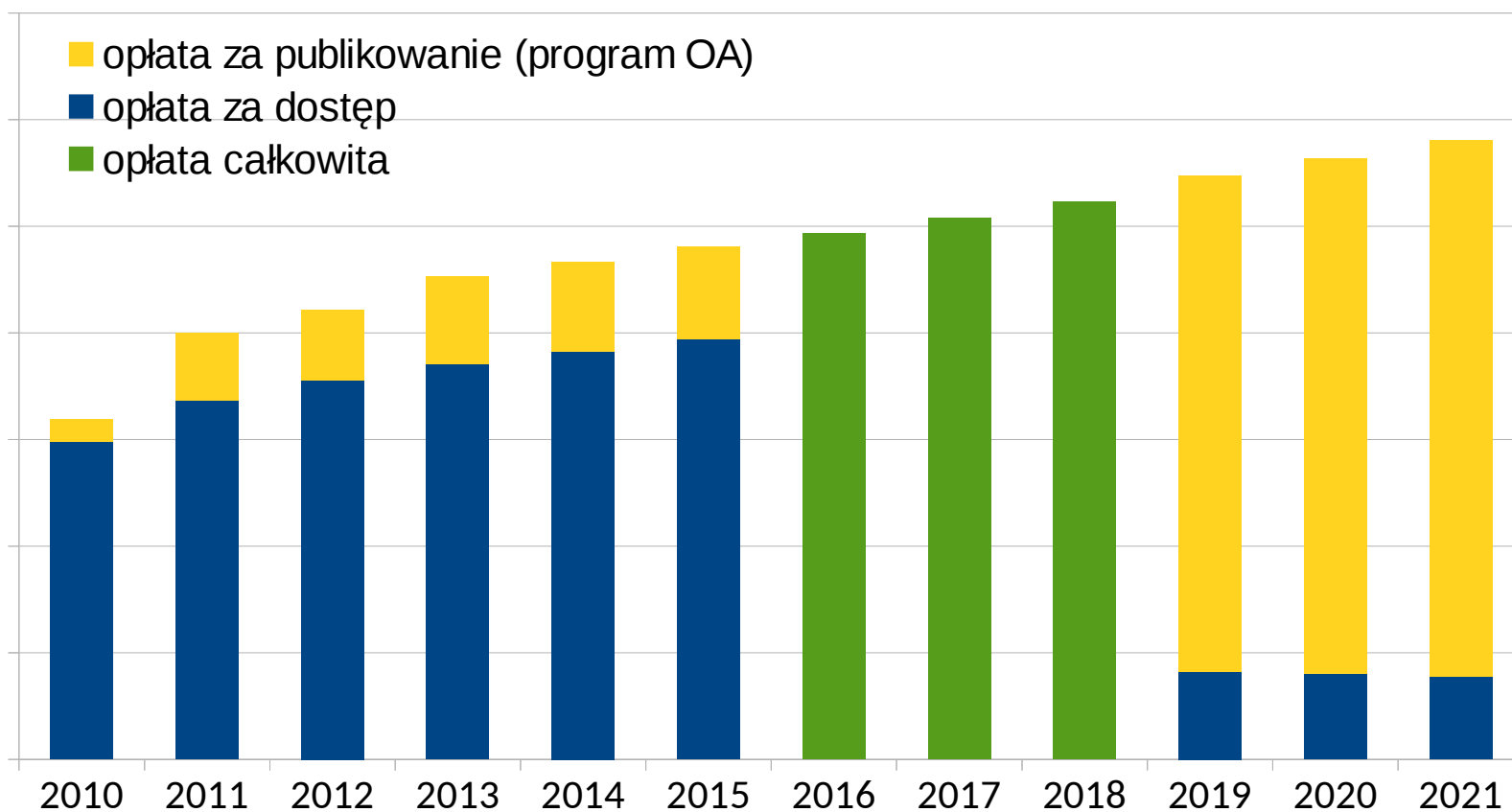

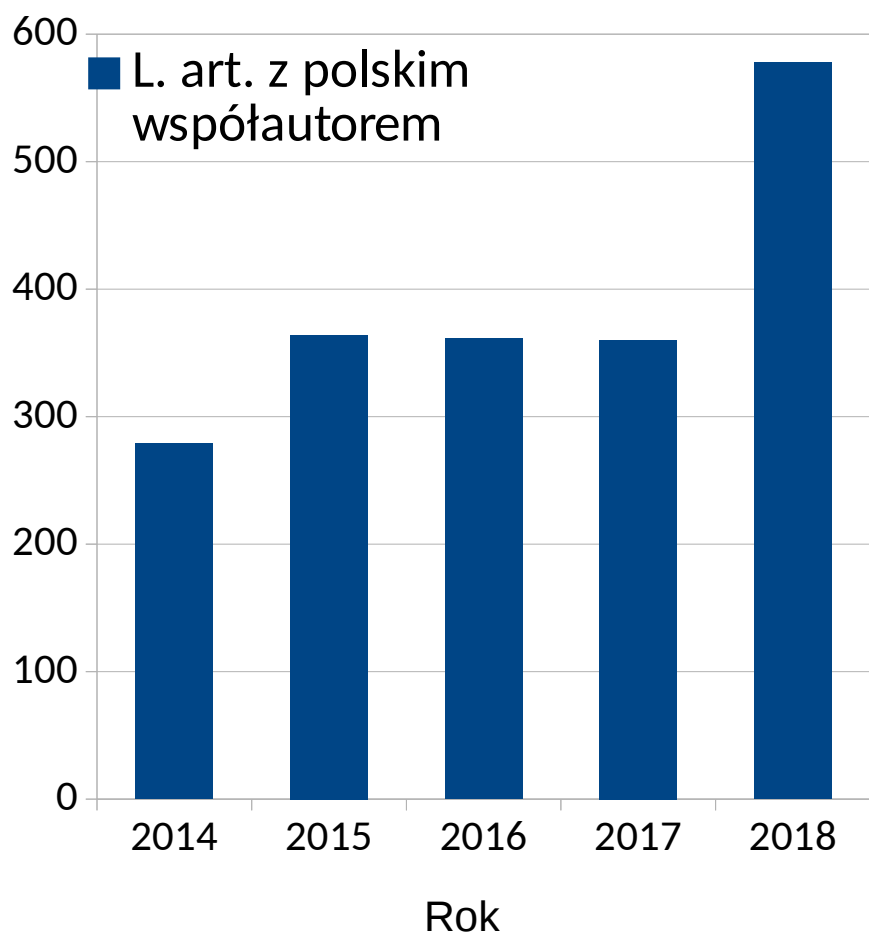
